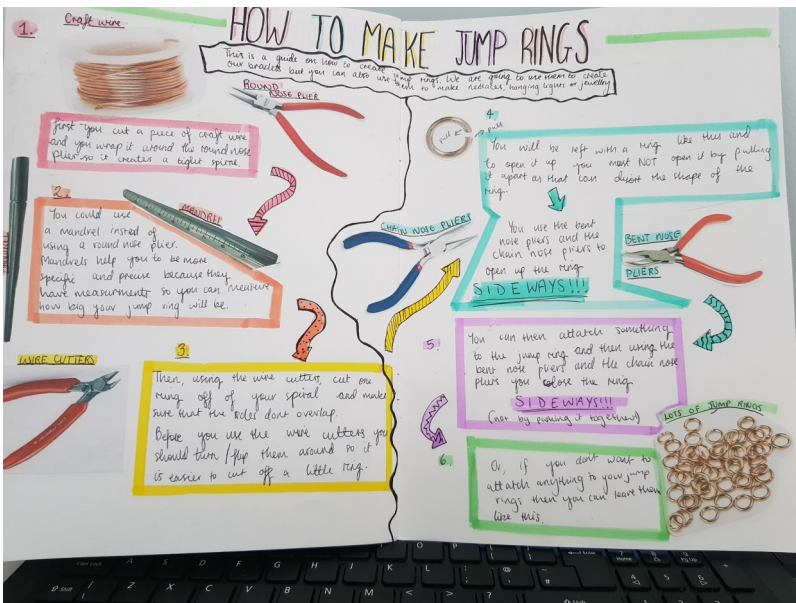
### Art Department
