

## YEAR 10 PERFORM AT THE ASHCROFT

The Shakespeare Schools Festival runs throughout October and November, giving over 1,000 schools the opportunity to perform at one of over 100 theatres on over 300 performance nights. Piya Varma and Temi Alao performed the ambitious Antonio and Sebastian with real flair and they were admirably supported by Rhea Patel as Gonzalo, Yasmin Lloyd as Francisco and Jessica Grant as Alonso. The physical creation of the storm itself, led beautifully by Leah Watkins, India Patel and Shivani Patel, was a real highlight, with many audience members commenting on the success of this opening scene.
