- Scholars will receive our Music Scholars pin badge to proudly wear on the lapel of their school blazer.
- Each scholar will be assigned a scholar mentor and will receive a 30 minute session with them each week. This may involve extra theory work for an examination, practise time with the mentor (who is a professional accompanist) or chamber music.
- Scholars are expected to take leading roles in ensembles and may be asked to assist
 with younger students, either mentoring or helping with more junior groups. You
 should attend all relevant choirs for your age and ability.
- Scholars will be given many performing opportunities throughout the year. This will include assembly performances and scholar recitals both in and out of school.
- You will be part of a small ensemble and take part in the annual Chamber Music Festival at school.
- Scholars are required to assist the Music department on open days as a performer and ambassador.
- You should take every opportunity to help promote Music in the school though your attitude and participation.
