SPORTS SCHOLARSHIP



At 11+ sports scholarships may be awarded to girls who have a significant strength in the sports offered at Croydon High School or who are outstanding all-rounders, displaying potential. Sports scholars must pass the entrance examination.

The school has outstanding facilities, including a purpose built gymnasium, a sports hall, a 25 metre swimming pool, eight tennis courts, a floodlit all-weather pitch and ample space in our 20 acre grounds for athletics and games. In addition, there is a dance studio, a fitness room and six netball courts, three of which have floodlights and newly installed cricket nets in the sports hall.

We are very proud at Croydon High School to be able to offer a wide variety of activities and coaching not only to our elite sportswomen but to all those girls who just want to enjoy physical activity and widen their recreational opportunities. The school enjoys a national reputation for its high standard of sport and major titles have been gained in a number of activities.

Croydon High School runs short and long haul sports tours and we have recently toured to Condover Hall, Shropshire, South Africa, Barbados and Spain.

Candidates whose application shows outstanding achievement and potential will be shortlisted to attend a day of assessment.

The girls will all show netball, hockey, athletics and swimming, and have the opportunity to show their skills in cricket, football, gymnastics, dance and tennis if any of these are their areas of strength.

Applications must be made by 6 November 2023.

The initial sports assessments will take place week commencing 27 November 2023, and there may be a second assessment session during the spring term for some pupils. We will be in touch if this is the case.

- Assist in leading key stage 3 clubs when in key stage 4
- Engage with our Sports Scholarship Programme by attending appropriate lectures/outings etc

- Write and present PE subject reports
- Mentor younger sports scholars (Sixth Form only)
