CONDITIONS OF SCHOLARSHIPS AND AWARDS

Standard Terms and Conditions:

The Scholarship/Award Conditions are supplemental to and should be read in conjunction with the Girls' Day School Trust ("GDST") Terms and Conditions. Terms defined in the GDST Terms and Conditions shall have the same meaning in the Scholarship/Award Conditions unless the context requires otherwise.

1. Obligations of the pupil:

A pupil who is the subject of a Scholarship/Award is required to work hard, to contribute positively to the life of the School, to be a credit to the School and to set a good example to other pupils.

A pupil who is the subject of an **Academic Scholarship/Award** is expected to maintain excellent effort and academic achievement in their subjects. This award should continue throughout a pupil's time at Croydon High Senior School, until the end of the Sixth Form. At Year 11 a further Scholarship award may be available for girls showing outstanding potential for further Academic Study in two chosen subjects for A Level.

2. Obligations of the Parent/s:

Parents are expected to support and encourage their daughter to achieve the purposes of the Scholarship/Award and to uphold the aims and the excellent reputation of the School.

3. Withdrawal of the Scholarship/Award:

The Scholarship/Award may be withdrawn at the discretion of the Headmistress. If, in the opinion of the Headmistress, the pupil or a parent has not complied with the obligations set out above or if she has fallen below the required standards of conduct and work, one term's notice will be given for withdrawal of the Scholarship/Award. Additionally, exclusion of a pupil may lead to an immediate withdrawal of the Scholarship/Award.

4. Review of the Scholarship/Award:

At the end of each academic year, the Headmistress will review the achievement and progress made by the pupil. The Scholarship/Award may be withdrawn by written notice sent to the parent if, in her opinion, the pupil's performance has fallen below the standard required by the Scholarship/Award.

5. Fees in lieu of notice:

For the avoidance of doubt, where fees in lieu of notice are due this will be full fees for a school term with no allowance for Scholarship/Award.
